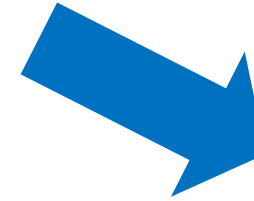


I performed Christmas songs around the Christmas tree in front of an audience.
