# YEAR GROUP EXPECTATIONS

- The class teacher will read to the children daily and an adult will listen to children read at least once a week. Children identified as needing extra help with their reading will read to an adult in school more often.

# RSE (RELATIONSHIPS & SEX EDUCATION)

RSE lessons happen in the final half term of the year.

Since September 2020, Relationships Education has been compulsory for all pupils receiving primary education, however you can withdraw your child from the sex education elements of RSE. You will be informed when this is taking place towards the end of the year. There will be a questionnaire to follow at a later date.

## **Year 3 cover;**

- Identify different types of relationships;
- Understand what is meant by the term body space (or personal space);
- Recognise that babies come from the joining of an egg and sperm;
- Explain what happens when an egg doesn't meet a sperm;
- Understand that for girls, periods are a normal part of puberty.

## **Year 4 cover;**

- Emotional and physical changes that happen during puberty
- Key facts about the menstrual cycle
- Knowing the difference between a safe and an unsafe secret
- Different types of stable, caring relationships including same and opposite sex partners.
